Learner-centred learning

- Active involvement: Learning is most effective when students actively

Experience-based learning

- Internal resources: Adults bring a wealth of personal experience to their learning, which serves as a valuable resource. At TLC, teachers integrate students' experiences into the learning process, making courses more relevant.
- Practical learning: Activities are designed to enable students to apply their knowledge immediately, whether in professional or personal contexts.

Intrinsic motivation

- Personal and professional objectives: Courses are designed to meet students'
 specific professional, academic and personal objectives. TLC strives to offer
 personalised learning pathways, whether for exam purposes (e.g. the fide test)
 or to improve skills in a professional context.
- Recognition of progress: By providing regular feedback and encouraging learners to assess their own progress, TLC boosts student motivation by showing them tangible results.

Adapting to the constraints of adults

- Flexibility: Aware of the multiple responsibilities of adults (work, family, etc.), TLC offers flexible course timetables and hybrid learning solutions (face-to-face and distance learning) to make it easier for students to fit courses into their schedules.
- Real-life problem solving: The teaching approach aims to offer skills that can be directly applied to real-life situations that students face in their daily or professional lives.

Collaborative learning

- Group learning: Group courses encourage students to share their experiences, thereby strengthening group cohesion and social learning. TLC values interaction and diversity of perspectives to enrich the learning process.
- Local partnerships: TLC works in collaboration with local companies and associations to offer courses adapted to the specific needs of the sector (hotels, tourism, local multinationals, etc.).
